Prerequisite(s), Corequisite(s), and Recommended Background	Many of the Professional Diploma in Accounting courses have prerequisite, corequisite and/or recommended background requirements that are above and beyond the 10 courses in the program. As a result, completion of this program may take more than one year of study. Check prerequisites and corequisites in the current Academic Calendar or Timetable for each course before registering.
Residence Requirement	Students must complete a minimum of five courses towards the Professional Diploma in Accounting at the University of Lethbridge.
Time Limit	All Professional Diploma in Accounting requirements must be completed within five years after acceptance into the Faculty of Management.
Minimum Grade Requirement	A minimum grade of 'C-' is required in all courses taken towards a Certificate program. A minimum grade of 'C-' is required in all Management courses to meet Professional Diploma in Accounting requirements. It is important to note that professional bodies (CPA) have their own minimum grade requirements. For further information, please contact an academic advisor or professional body representative.
