*** Residence Requirement** - Students must complete all third and fourth year courses (20 course equivalents/60.0 credit hours), including a minimum of two of the four electives at the U of L.

Time Limits - All degree requirements must be completed within seven years of the first Nursing course used for credit towards the degree.

Minimum Grade Requirements - A minimum grade of C is required in Nursing 1163 and Nursing 1173. A student who receives a grade of C- or less must repeat the course prior to proceeding in the program. A minimum grade of C- is required in all other Nursing courses, Biology 1160/(Kinesiology 1160/Health Sciences 1160), Biology 1161/(Kinesiology 1161/Health Sciences 1161), and Biology 1162/Biology 2xxx (or equivalents).
