**Time Limits** - All degree requirements must be completed within six years of the first Nursing course used for credit towards the degree.

**Minimum Grade Requirements** - A minimum grade of C is required in Nursing 1182. A student who receives a grade of C- or less must repeat the course prior to proceeding in the program. A minimum grade of C- is required in all other Nursing courses.
