Time Limits - All degree requirements must be completed within six years of the first Nursing course used for credit towards the degree. See Academic Regulations, Residence Requirements and Time Limits, p. 63 in the 2019/2020 Calendar.

Minimum Grade Requirements - A minimum grade of C is required in Nursing 1182. A student who receives a grade of C- or less must repeat the course prior to proceeding in the program. A minimum grade of C- is required in all other Nursing courses.
