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Program Requirements

Completion of at least 6 courses (18.0 credit hours) with cumulative and graduation grade point averages of at least 2.00.

Minimum Grade Requirement

A minimum grade of 'C-' is required in all courses meeting Post-Bachelor Certificate in Advanced Accounting requirements. Residence Requirement

Students must complete at least 5 courses towards the Post-Bachelor Certificate in Advanced Accounting at the University of Lethbridge. Program Length

Completion of this program may take more than one year of study. All Post-Bachelor Certificate in Advanced Accounting requirements must be completed within 5 years after acceptance into the Dhillon School of Business.
