- \_\_\_\_\_ Completion of a seven-course modified Liberal Education List Requirement. Two courses from each of List II: Social Sciences and List III: Science, and three additional courses from List II and/or List III. Social Science and Science courses from the diploma may be used to meet this requirement. A maximum of four courses from one department may be counted toward this requirement. ## Faculty of Education Admission

Students begin in the Pre-Post-Diploma program. After completion of one or two terms, including Education 2500, students must apply for admission to the Faculty of Education.

To be considered for admission to the Faculty of Education, successful completion of the following is required:

**Note:** *Due to course sequencing, the Faculty of Fine Arts recommends students to complete 30 courses prior to applying to the Faculty of Education.*

- \_\_\_\_\_ 14 graded term courses (42.0 credit hours).
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Education Admission GPA:** Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 on all U of L and transferable courses taken within the terms containing the last 14 courses (42.0 credit hours). If any part of the diploma falls within the last 14 courses (42.0 credit hours), the entirety of the diploma (i.e., diploma GPA) is included in the calculation. All courses must be graded.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Minimum of five courses (15.0 credit hours) in the major.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Major GPA:** Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 on all graded courses comprising the major, including all transferable courses.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Credit in Education 2500 - Orientation to Teaching (or equivalent) prior to the fall program intake, including a favourable recommendation from the instructor.
