Certificate in Arts and Science



The Certificate in Arts and Science is a university-level certificate program that may be completed in as little as one year of full-time study or may be completed on a part-time basis. Students who complete the certificate may qualify for a degree program, and use their certificate credits towards their degree, through the Post-Secondary Admission Route.

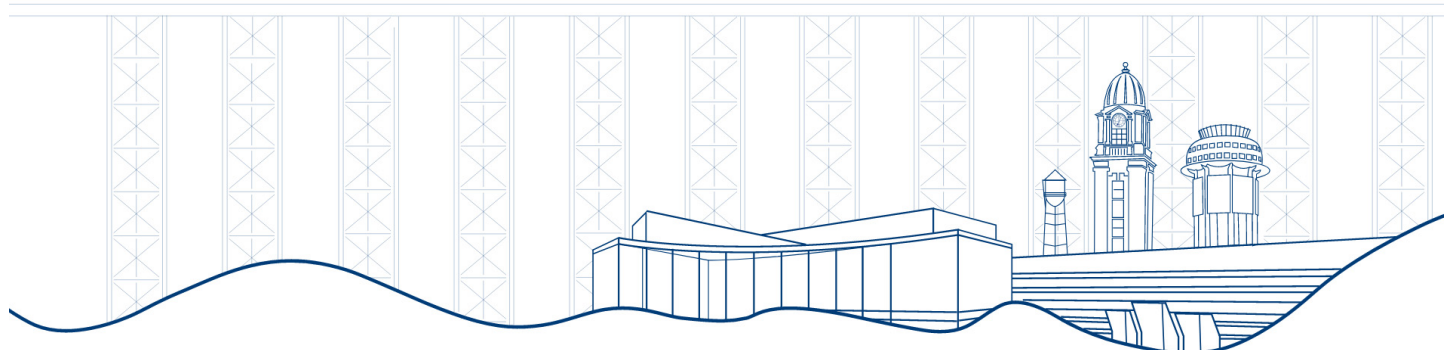
