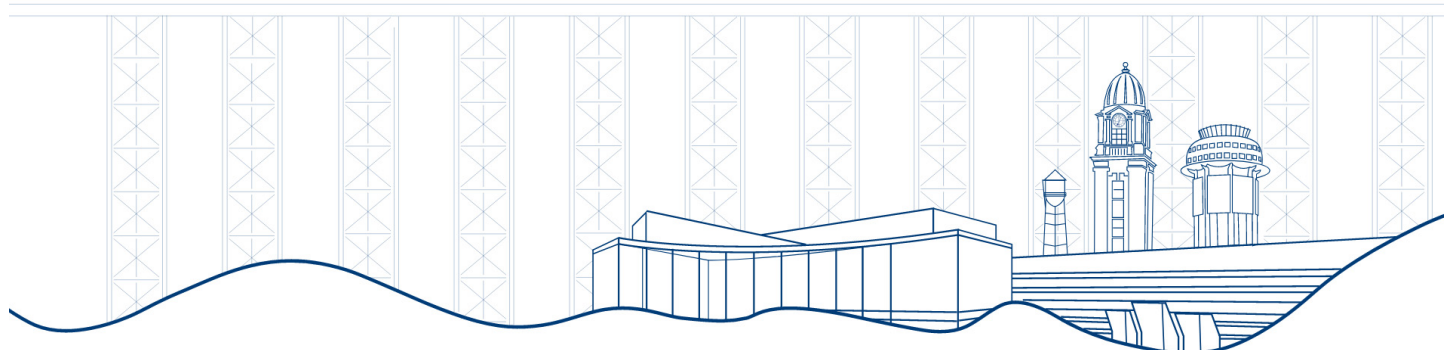

General Requirements

Students must meet the academic standards, program requirements, and graduation requirements according to the regulations set by the Dhillon School of Business, and as outlined in the Calendar including, but not limited to:

- _____ Successful completion of at least 6 courses (18.0 credit hours) with cumulative and graduation GPAs of at least 2.00 (on the University of Lethbridge 4.0 scale).
- _____ A minimum grade of 'C-' is required in all courses meeting requirements for the Post-Bachelor Certificate in Advanced Accounting program. It is important to note that the CPA professional body has their own minimum grade requirements. For further information, please contact an academic advisor or professional body representative.
- _____ Residence Requirement: Students must complete at least 5 courses towards the Post-Bachelor Certificate in Advanced Accounting at the University of Lethbridge. Post-Bachelor Certificate in Advanced Accounting students must also complete 5 of the following at the University of Lethbridge: Accounting 3100, Accounting 3101, Accounting 3130, Accounting 3131, Accounting 3151, Accounting 3160, Accounting 3171, Accounting 3180, Accounting 3190, Accounting 4110, Accounting 4125/ Agricultural Enterprise Management 4125, Accounting 4130, Accounting 4151, Accounting 4160.
- _____ All Post-Bachelor Certificate in Advanced Accounting requirements must be completed within 5 years after acceptance into the Dhillon School of Business
