The Faculty of Arts and Science and the Dhillon School of Business, and Faculty of Fine Arts and the Dhillon School of Business jointly offer a 50-course (150.0 credit hour) Combined Degrees program leading to the degrees Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) or Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) and Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.). Upon successful completion of the Combined Degrees program, the student receives the B.A. or B.Sc. degree from the Faculty of Arts and Science or Faculty of Fine Arts and the B.B.A. degree from the Dhillon School of Business. Applicants seeking the B.A./B.B.A. or B.Sc./B.B.A. degrees must declare distinct majors in the Combined Degrees program.



Required courses and notes

B.A. or B.Sc. Requirements (30 Courses)

The minimum required number of courses is different for each Arts and Science or Fine Arts major (see **Combined Degrees** in the 2026/2027 University of Lethbridge Calendar, www.ulethbridge.ca/ross/academic-calendar). Arts and Science, Fine Arts, and Liberal Education courses only. Each course will be listed only once under either "Major Requirements" or "Electives".

Residence requirement: Students must complete a minimum of 30 courses at the University of Lethbridge, including 20 courses from disciplines offered by the Faculty of Arts and Science, Faculty of Fine Arts, or School of Liberal Education and 10 Dhillon School of Business courses at the 3000/4000 level.

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Liberal Education List Requirement

Only four courses (12.0 credit hours) in total may be counted from any one discipline toward the Lib Ed Requirement. Disciplines are identified by separate course subject codes. Cross-listed courses count toward the limit for both disciplines (e.g. Geography 3225/Global Business 3225 counts toward the limit for Geography and Dhillon School of Business courses).

Only four courses (12.0 credit hours) in total from the Faculty of Education (EDUC), Faculty of Health Sciences (AMHC, HLSC, INHL, NURS, PUBH, and TREC), and the Dhillon School of Business (ACCT, AGEM, DGTR, FINC, GLBU, HRLR, IGBM, MGT, and MKTG) may be counted towards the Lib Ed Requirement.

B.A. or B.Sc. General Requirements

- _____ A minimum of 30 courses (90.0 credit hours) from disciplines offered by the Faculty of Arts and Science, Faculty of Fine Arts, or School of Liberal Education with a GPA of at least 2.00.
- _____ A maximum of three Independent Study courses (9.0 credit hours) may be completed for credit towards the degree.
- _____ A maximum of three Disciplinary Credit Applied Studies courses (9.0 credit hours) may be completed for credit towards the degree. Students may, in addition, complete Applied Studies 2000, 2001, 2010, and 2011. For Art majors, Museum Studies Internship courses (Museum Studies 4000, 4001, and 4002) are included in this limit.
- _____ A maximum of 17 courses (51.0 credit hours) may be completed from any one discipline for credit towards the degree (see **Faculty of Arts and Science** in the 2026/2027 University of Lethbridge Calendar, www.ulethbridge.ca/ross/academic-calendar). Disciplines are identified by a specific course label (e.g. KNES, ASTR, and HIST are separate disciplines).
- _____ A maximum of six credit hours in Activity courses (i.e. courses labelled PHAC and MUSE) may be completed for credit towards the degree, except for Kinesiology majors (not more than 15.0 credit hours) and Music majors (not more than 12.0 credit hours).
- _____ Residence requirement: at least 20 courses (60.0 credit hours) from disciplines offered by the Faculty of Arts and Science, Faculty of Fine Arts, or School of Liberal Education must be completed at the University of Lethbridge.

A **maximum** of 10 courses (30.0 credit hours) may be completed at the 1000 level (or lower) for credit towards the degree, excluding Activity courses (labelled PHAC and MUSE) and courses numbered in the range of 0520 to 0530.

B.B.A. General Requirements

Students must meet the academic standards, program requirements, and graduation requirements according to the regulations set by the Dhillon School of Business, and as outlined in the Calendar including, but not limited to:

- _____ A minimum grade of 'C-' is required in Economics 1010; Economics 1012; Statistics 1770; Writing 1000 or English 1900; all Dhillon School of Business courses, including those cross-listed with Dhillon School of Business courses; and all courses in the major marked with an asterisk (*).
- _____ A minimum graduation GPA of 2.00 in Dhillon School of Business courses is required (see **Dhillon School of Business** in the 2026/2027 University of Lethbridge Calendar, www.ulethbridge.ca/ross/academic-calendar). A student must also attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 on courses taken at the University of Lethbridge.
- _____ All degree requirements must be completed within 10 years after admission to the Dhillon School of Business.
- _____ Completion of a minimum of 20 Dhillon School of Business courses including all courses required for the Management major.
- _____ Residence requirement: at least 10 courses from the Dhillon School of Business at the 3000/4000 level, including Management 3031 and Management 4090, must be completed at the University of Lethbridge. Accounting majors must complete five of the following courses at the University of Lethbridge: Accounting 3100, Accounting 3101, Accounting 3130, Accounting 3131, Accounting 3151, Accounting 3160, Accounting 3171, Accounting 3180, Accounting 3190, Accounting 4110, Accounting 4125/Agricultural Enterprise Management 4125, Accounting 4130, Accounting 4151, Accounting 4160. Economics and Political Science majors can use unspecified 3000/4000 Economics and Political Science courses respectively taken at the University of Lethbridge, toward the Dhillon School of Business residence requirement. Finance majors must complete all courses from the following list, and which are part of their program, at the University of Lethbridge: Finance 3412, Finance 3441, Finance 3460, Finance 3470, Finance 3480, Finance 4421, Finance 4430, Finance 4451
