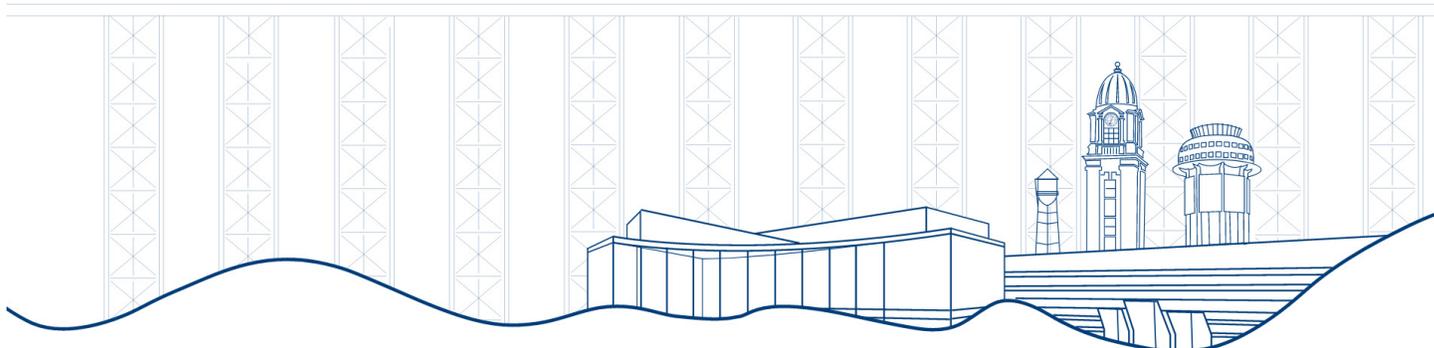

**Liberal Education List Requirement and/or Electives**

Only four courses (12.0 credit hours) in total may be counted from any one discipline toward the Lib Ed Requirement. Disciplines are identified by separate course subject codes.

Only four courses (12.0 credit hours) in total from the Faculty of Education (EDUC), Faculty of Health Sciences (AMHC, HLSC, INHL, NURS, PUBH, and TREC), and the Dhillon School of Business (ACCT, AGEM, DGTR, FINC, GLBU, HRLR, IGBM, MGT, and MKTG) may be counted towards the Lib Ed Requirement.

**B.F.A General Requirements**

**Faculty of Fine Arts**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Completion of at least 15 courses from disciplines offered by the Faculty of Fine Arts, the Faculty of Arts and Science, or the School of Liberal Education with a GPA of at least 2.00 (on the University of Lethbridge 4.0 scale).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Completion of a minimum of eight courses (24.0 credit hours) in the discipline with a GPA of at least 2.50 (on the University of Lethbridge 4.0 scale).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Completion of a seven-course modified Liberal Education List Requirement. Two courses from each of List II: Social Sciences and List III: Science, and three additional courses from List II and/or List III. Social Science and Science courses from the diploma may be used to meet this requirement.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Completion of at least eight courses (24.0 credit hours) at the 3000/4000 level.
- \_\_\_\_\_ A maximum of three Independent Studies.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The entire program must be approved in advance by an academic advisor in the Faculty of Fine Arts.

**Residence Requirement**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Completion of a minimum of 35 courses (105.0 credit hours) at the University of Lethbridge, including a minimum of eight courses (24.0 credit hours) in the discipline (Art, Art History, Drama, Museum Studies, or Music) and 20 Education courses (60.0 credit hours).

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**Faculty of Education Admission**

To be considered for admission to the Faculty of Education, successful completion of the following is required:

**Note:** Due to course sequencing, the Faculty of Fine Arts recommends students to complete 30 courses prior to applying to the Faculty of Education.

- 14 graded term courses (42.0 credit hours).
- **Education Admission GPA:** Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 on all U of L and transferable courses taken within the terms containing the last 14 courses (42.0 credit hours). If any part of the diploma falls within the last 14 courses (42.0 credit hours), the entirety of the diploma (i.e., diploma GPA) is included in the calculation. All courses must be graded.
- Minimum of five courses (15.0 credit hours) in the major.
- **Major GPA:** Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 on all graded courses comprising the major, including all transferable courses.
- Credit in Education 2500 - Orientation to Teaching (or equivalent) prior to the fall program intake, including a favourable recommendation from the instructor.

**Bachelor of Education**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Completion of the equivalent of 20 courses (60.0 credit hours) in Education
- \_\_\_\_\_ Completion of the Education teaching major with a cumulative GPA of 2.50 (on the University of Lethbridge 4.0 scale).
- \_\_\_\_\_ A cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher (on the University of Lethbridge 4.0 scale) in all courses taken after admission to the Faculty of Education.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Residence requirement: a minimum of 15 courses (45.0 credit hours) offered by the Faculty of Education must be completed at the University of Lethbridge.

**Note:** In order to have a teaching minor endorsed on the official academic transcript, a GPA of 2.50 or higher on all non-Education courses comprising the minor and, additionally, a minimum B- in the appropriate Education methods course is required.
